



**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE** – February 5, 2009 – As a result of the expansion of the Peanut Corporation of America’s Salmonella recall, Country Home Bakers of Atlanta, Georgia is initiating a nation-wide recall of raw, frozen peanut butter cookie dough distributed to Food Service and Retail customers because of possible health risks.

*Salmonella* is an organism, which can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems. Healthy persons infected with Salmonella often experience fever, diarrhea (which may be bloody), nausea, vomiting and abdominal pain. The recall is for raw, frozen individual cookie dough pucks, bulk packed, having the following use by date codes:
